



INFORMATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE ITALIAN LAW D. LGS. 196/03 ART. 13 ON PRIVACY

We inform You that Your personal data will be treated by our firm with papery and electronic means too, in the respect of the D.Lgs. n. 196/03. In accordance with such law, the treatment will be based on the principles of correctness, right, transparency and guardianship of Your reservation and rights.

The treatment will be used for:

- Exertion of rights and execution of obligations coming from contract and law;
- for the administrative management, bookkeeping, fiscal, social security.

Your personal data provision is optional, except in case a normative and/or contractual obligation is foreseen. In this case the refusal of data provision may cause the total or partial impossibility to have contractual relationships with You. The diffusion of the data from us acquired, will remain in our concern, but they can be communicated to tax advisors, legal, tributary, administrative, Banking institutes, Social Security and Assurances for the realization of the finalities above suitable.

Rights foreseen by the art. 7 D.Lgses. 196/03:

1. A data subject has the right to obtain the confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
2. A data subject has the right to be informed:
 - a) of the source of the personal data;
 - b) of the purposes and methods of the processing;
 - c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;
 - d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2)
 - e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing
3. A data subject has the right to obtain:
 - a) updating, rectification, or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
 - b) erasure, anonymization or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;
 - c) Certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to the contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected
4. A data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part:
 - a) on legitimate grounds, to processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
 - b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys
